KEY FACTS:

ADPEP is a six-hour, alcohol & drug prevention and education format.

ADPEP is Information Based.

ADPEP is delivered in three, two-hour sessions.

ADPEP includes “homework” to help participants understand and integrate the information.

ADPEP covers topics pertaining to alcohol and drugs (including the power of choice, drug specific information, family systems, the effects of substance abuse on adolescents, addiction, etc.)

ADPEP Cost: \$100.00 per person per six-hour program (cash, money order, or check accepted.)
